Friday, April 20th at 1:00 PM

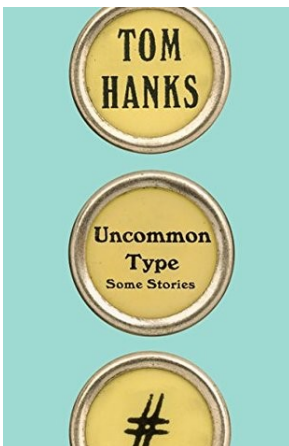
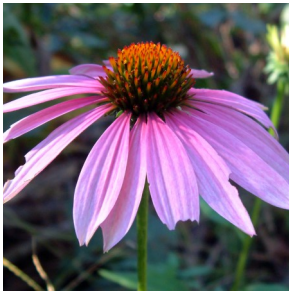
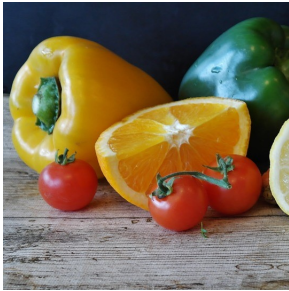
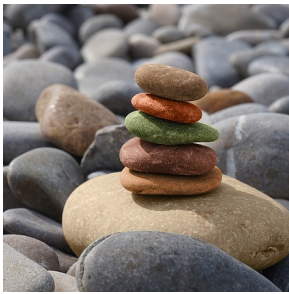
