Friday, May 18th at 1:00 PM

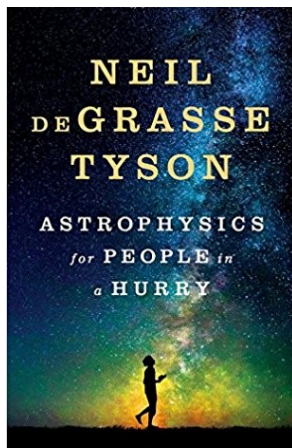
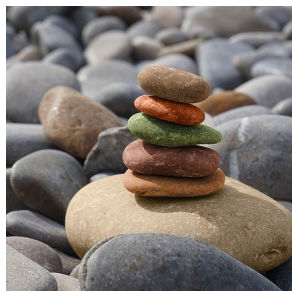
